Dear Scripps ACO Member,

CMS has released the 2024 5% APM (Alternative Payment Model) Incentive Payments earlier this month. By virtue of your participation in the Scripps Accountable Care Organization (ACO) Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP) in 2022, you are receiving a bonus payment amounting to 5% of your 2023 Medicare Part B covered professional services payments. This is because the Scripps ACO achieved APM status for the 2022 performance year.

Payment is based upon your Tax Identification Number (TIN). Payment information at the individual level based upon your National Provider Identifier (NPI) can be found by accessing your PECOS or QPP account. These payments are made possible because the Scripps ACO has made significant investments of time and resources to achieve APM status thus allowing our members to qualify for these bonuses.

We are now entering our eighth year in the MSSP, and we continue to strive to achieve shared savings based upon our cost and quality performance. To achieve this, we need the active support and participation of our members in established and future performance improvement activities. Please review the attached document for the list of current programs and call to action.

We thank you for your participation in the Scripps ACO and MSSP and, with your partnership, hope to continue our goal of delivering value-based, high-quality patient care. This will allow future Medicare bonus payments to you as well as increase our opportunity for shared savings for our ACO and its participants.
